ENGINEERING REPORT
BOROUGH OF WEST CAPE MAY**

1. FY 2018 Municipal Aid Application

A. NJDOT has awarded a Municipal Aid Grant of \$160,000.00 to the Borough of West Cape May for the Reconstruction of Leaming Avenue.

1. The Municipal Aid Application includes pavement reconstruction (widen from 28' to 32'), concrete curb and sidewalk (both sides), 2-5' wide bike paths and storm drainage.
2. The proposed roadway section will consist of 2-11' wide travel lanes, 2-5' wide bike lanes.
3. The Total Grant Request was in the amount of \$376,710.00

2. Borough Wide Street Improvements (Contracts 2 & 3)

1. Reconstruction of Leaming Avenue from Park Boulevard to Cape Island Creek.

- “Old” 4th Avenue to the end of the gravel turnaround.
- Brown Avenue from 5th Street to 6th Street.
- Goldbeaten Alley from Pacific Avenue to Atlantic Avenue.

A. Turning counts (vehicles, pedestrians & cyclist) completed.

B. Vehicular Speed Analysis

1. Speed sign and trailer have arrived and are being programmed.
2. Counts to be completed by late September.
3. Report with recommendations to be issued by early October.

6. Storm Drainage

A. Meetings with County and Cape May City are being set up to discuss the various storm water issues impacting West Cape May.
