- 1.) FY 2010 USDA RD Sanitary Sewer Extension, Water Main Replacement and Meter Installation Program and FY 2012 NJDOT Municipal Aid/Bike Path
 - Status:
 - USDA made the formal announcement of the grant/loan in the amount of \$708,000 Grant and \$2,305,000 Loan.
 - Work on Park Boulevard from Myrtle Street to Learning Avenue is substantially complete. Contractor to complete punchlist.
 - A total of twenty-six (26) parallel parking spaces have been created along side the bike path.
 - Landis and Stewart pavement remediation: On-site meeting with Contractor preparing remediation proposal, awaiting survey data.
 - 3rd, 4th and 5th Avenues are paved.
 - Contractor has completed the final pavement on Central Avenue, from Broadway to Leaming Avenue, including Willow Avenue, Maple Avenue and Grant Avenue (south and north sides) and Park Boulevard from Leaming Avenue to Central Avenue
 - Remedial work on Landis Avenue and Stewart Avenue is completed.
 - Learning Avenue repair is completed
 - Remaining work:
 - a. Pavement markings and striping.
 - b. Punchlist.
 - c. The above items are weather dependent.
 - 2.) RV&W working with Triad Associates in preparing Determination of Eligibility Request to USDA to include the Replacement of the Myrtle Avenue Sanitary Intercept Sewer from Broadway to Park Boulevard and the Rehabilitation of the Broadway Sanitary Sewer Pump Station
