NEW BUSINESS:

Environmental Resource Inventory for West Cape May Borough:

Planning-Zoning Board Member, and Environmental Commission (EC) Member, Bob Hewitt presented a power point presentation based on the Environmental Resource Inventory (ERI) to the Planning Board Members. Also present to help in the discussion was Tom Bockett, fellow member of the EC. Mr. Hewitt explained that the goal of the ERI is to provide easy access to environmental data to the Borough in order to help the Borough make more informed decisions and to better protect its natural resources. He said the ultimate idea is to have the Planning Board adopt the ERI as part of the sustainability element of the Borough Master Plan.

Mr. Hewitt highlighted the following three items of the ERI: ground water & drinking water, surface water, and environmentally critical areas. He said the EC would come up with concrete plans for the three issues discussed and present recommendations to the Planning Board Members.
